<p><b>9<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> Uniform Shirt:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Black Polo</li> <li>✓ White Polo</li> <li>✓ Any school approved SJH t-shirt</li> </ul> <p><b>7<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> Uniform Shirt:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Gold Polo</li> <li>✓ Any school approved SJH t-shirt (Friday's only)</li> <li>✓ T-shirt under uniform shirt MUST be black, white, gold or gray</li> </ul> <p><b>7<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup>:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Shirts MUST be tucked in at all times. (Males and Females)</li> <li>✓ No midribs showing at anytime</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Color: Khaki (no denim)</li> <li>✓ Style: Pants, shorts, capris, skorts, skirts</li> <li>✓ <b>Shorts, skirts, skorts (no shorter than 3 inches above the knee)</b></li> <li>✓ Students are prohibited from wearing cargo pants, cargo shorts, drawstring clothing, joggers and/or sweatpants</li> <li>✓ Worn at the natural waist (above hip bone)</li> <li>✓ Appropriate fit (not too loose or too tight – administrator discretion)</li> <li>✓ No holes in clothing, no rolled shorts and bottoms must be hemmed</li> </ul>	<p><b>9<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> School ID:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Worn at all times around the neck</li> <li>✓ Black lanyard</li> <li>✓ Temporary ID's must be worn on the upper chest.</li> <li>✓ Defacing ID is prohibited</li> </ul> <p><b>7<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> School ID:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Worn at all times around the neck</li> <li>✓ Gold lanyard</li> <li>✓ Temporary ID's must be worn on the upper chest.</li> <li>✓ Defacing ID is prohibited</li> </ul>

		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Shoes must be enclosed front &amp; back.</li> <li>✓ Heels should be no more than 2 inches high</li> <li>✓ No platforms, sandals, flip flops, house slippers, cleated shoes, athletic slides, or "croc" style shoes.</li> <li>✓ Socks must be worn at all times</li> <li>✓ Socks or tights must be white, khaki, black, navy, gray or school approved color</li> <li>✓ Students are prohibited from wearing socks with inappropriate designs</li> </ul>	
SWEATERS / JACKETS / COATS/ SWEATSHIRTS/SWEATERS		BELTS	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ <b>Beginning 2018-2019 school year: NO HOODS ON JACKETS, SWEATSHIRTS, SWEATERS and COATS</b></li> <li>✓ Colors: Solid white, gold, black, or gray (denim jackets are prohibited)</li> <li>✓ Small logos approximately 2 inches in size are permitted pending administration approval</li> <li>✓ School organization jackets and/or sweatshirts must be approved by administration</li> <li>✓ May NOT be altered or cut in any way</li> <li>✓ Official athletic game day attire may be worn when assigned by coach</li> </ul>		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ MUST be worn with pants/bottoms</li> </ul>	
		ACCESSORIES	
<th style="background-color: yellow;">PROFESSIONAL DRESS MONDAYS - OPTIONAL</th>		PROFESSIONAL DRESS MONDAYS - OPTIONAL	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Earrings must be worn in the ear lobes only and may be no larger than 1" in diameter and/or length</li> <li>✓ No body piercings (male or female)</li> <li>✓ Ear buds, headphones, and cell phones should not be seen, heard, or in use</li> <li>✓ <b>No sunglasses, hoods, hats, curlers, wraps, or other headgear worn in the building</b></li> <li>✓ No blankets allowed</li> <li>✓ Jewelry is worn at the risk of the student</li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ <b>Optional beginning 2018-2019 school year: Student professional dress day</b></li> <li>✓ Shirts—Black or White button-down collared shirt</li> <li>✓ Collars must be worn down in the normal position; shirts must be tucked in at all times, and should be an appropriate size</li> <li>✓ Sweaters—Black V-Neck sweater with the school crest</li> <li>✓ Black, Gold or Combination Black/Gold Tie</li> </ul>
