

**School Year 2020-2021
Pass or Fail Option for Seniors**



What is the pass or fail option?

It is the decision of the local governing authority as to how to award credit. Bulletin 741 §2302 Uniform Grading Policy has been modified to allow senior Carnegie units to be reported with a Pass/Fail option.

What does it mean if this option is selected?

If the Pass/Fail option is utilized for senior course credit, it must be awarded for the entire course Carnegie unit. Pass/Fail options are not calculated into the Grade Point Average (GPA) for the purpose of Taylor Opportunity Program for Students (TOPS) . If the Pass/Fail option is selected, parents and students must consult with the school through the Individual Graduation Plan (IGP) process to determine if Pass/Fail shall be used and how this may impact the TOPS GPA requirements.

Deadline to submit form: May 15, 2020 (non Dual Enrollment courses), May 22, 2020 (Dual Enrollment courses)
