CELEBRATING NATIONAL WOMEN'S MONTH



In October 2020, Amy Coney Barrett became the fifth woman confirmed to the U.S. Supreme Court. She has had a long career in law as both a distinguished professor and judge, and currently serves as an Associate Justice of the U.S. Supreme Court. She is the first justice in 150 years who was confirmed without any support from the minority party. In pre-written remarks issued before her confirmation hearing, Barrett called her nomination to the Supreme Court the "honor of a lifetime."
